## What is HelpHub?

HelpHub is an interactive website where professionals can ask policy experts questions about healthcare (e.g., Medicaid, Marketplace, Medicare) and public benefits (e.g., SNAP, TANF) eligibility, enrollment, and access issues.

HelpHub users can post questions, have conversations, and share event notices or helpful resources. Questions range from enrollment practice issues (like how to submit income verification) to policy questions (such as eligibility of non-citizens for programs).
