*November 19-20, Essential Elements of Home-Based Primary Care™:* This live virtual workshop is designed for learners considering, or relatively new to, offering HBPC services for patients with complex medical conditions.



*House Calls 101: Introduction to Home-Based Primary Care:* This online course gives learners the chance to follow an HBPC provider and her medical assistant on a simulated house call, helping learners connect with the various HBPC assessment elements and visualize crafting an effective patient care plan. Learners will better understand typical steps taken before, during, and after a home visit, as well as characteristics and personal qualities that can enhance a provider's success in HBPC.



*House Call Practicum™:* This program with the Cleveland Clinic Medical Care at Home Program, our Practice Excellent Partner, offers an individualized learning opportunity of a ride-along day with a house call provider, shadowing day with the back-office support team, and optional third day observing the telemedicine program.
