## Fast Facts

49.6\% of adults aged 20 and over have high blood pressure and/or are taking antihypertensive medication.

Approximately 60\% of Americans aged 60 and over have hypertension.

Hypertension affects 1 in 4 adults! African Americans are at an increased risk of developing hypertension at a younger age and more frequently. ${ }^{3}$

In 2017, there were 32.8 million visits to physician offices where the patient's primary diagnosis was hypertension. 4

Heart disease and stroke are the first and third leading causes of death and a major cause of disability in Illinois! ${ }^{5}$

One person in the USA dies every 36 seconds from heart disease. ${ }^{6}$
$48 \%$ of all adults in the USA have some form of cardiovascular disease. ${ }^{6}$ From the Illinois Academy of Family Physicians
